FUR AND SKIN

Omega 3 Fatty Acids and Vitamin
A add luster and shine to your dog
and cats coat and eliminate dry
skin.

CARDIOVASCULAR

Evidence suggests Omega-3 fatty
acids may prevent certain cardiac
problems. High blood pressure has
been reduced in dogs
supplemented with fatty acids.

VISION

Omega-3 fatty acids and Vitamin
A are also essential for the
proper development and
maintenance of the retina and
visual cortex. Cats must be fed
Vitamin A already in the form of
retinal palmitate as they lack the
enzyme to convert beta carotene
to Vitamin A.
A lack of Vitamin A in puppies
relates directly to poor vision, fur
loss and low growth rates.

JOINTS AND BONES

Omega 3 Fatty Acids can help
reduce inflammation associated
with arthritis and other
inflammatory diseases.
Vitamin D regulates calcium
absorption and promotes normal
bone calcification. It is
necessary for bone and joint
formation.

CANCER

Omega-3 fatty acids have been
shown to slow the development
and metastasis certain cancers.
Omega-6 fatty acids, on the
other hand, have been shown to
stimulate tumor development.
Vitamin E is an powerful
antioxidant that reduces free
radicals (which may cause
cancer), plays a role in the
formation of cell membranes and
protects various hormones
against oxidation.

Commercially prepared pet foods and the natural diets of wild carnivores differ greatly in Omega 6: Omega 3 ratios. The wild canine/feline diet which is composed primarily of birds and small animals eaten whole is high in Omega 3 and low in Omega 6.

Commercial pet food is the reverse. Much of the food contains cereal grains which are high in Omega 6 and low in Omega 3. This unnatural ratio of Omega 6: Omega 3 impacts the health of pets in ways that veterinarians and nutritionist just beginning to understand.
